<u>Second Reading:</u> (Revelation 22:12-14, 16-17, 20) The last words of the Book of Revelation talk about the second coming of Christ.

<u>Gospel:</u> (John 17:20-26) We share in part of the great prayer which Jesus made on behalf of his present and future disciples during the Last Supper.
